



WASTE MANAGEMENT



Waste management involves the monitoring, collection, transport, processing and disposal of waste materials. The primary goal of effective waste management is to recycle or reuse as much material as possible to minimise the volume of waste going into landfill.

State Government levies and tipping fees to landfill continue to rise. While recycling and reuse is best environmental practice, it is also the easiest way to reduce waste disposal costs. As tenants share the full cost of waste disposal through monthly outgoings, you have the opportunity to directly reduce your business costs and improve profitability by managing waste effectively.

Individuals that do the wrong thing, such as contaminating recyclable waste streams or dumping rubbish add significant cost to your business.

If you see someone doing the wrong thing, please report it to Centre Management or your business will be contributing to the cost of their poor behaviour.

Casey Central aims to maximise recycling and resource recovery, with the goal to **divert 50% of all waste from landfill**. We need your support to achieve this.



PAPER AND CARDBOARD

Only place paper and cardboard in this compactor.



BOTTLES AND CANS

- Items must be placed in the recycling bins loose. i.e. bottles, cartons and cans cannot be in plastic bags.
- No general rubbish, cardboard or paper.



FOOD GRADE OIL

- Tip used cooking oil into the oil tank.
- Place empty oil drums into the bottles and cans recycling bins (please ensure containers are empty).



SOFT PLASTICS

- For clear shrink wrap plastic only.
- Any colored or printed wrap should be disposed into the landfill compactor.



ORGANICS

- All food scraps (pre and post cooking) can be collected, except for meat or fish.
- Floral off cuts can be disposed of in this bin.



LANDFILL

- All rubbish disposed into the general waste compactor goes to landfill.



PLEASE USE AS A LAST RESORT FOR DISPOSING OF WASTE!



The table below outlines which waste facilities are located in each dock.

*Note that not every dock has waste facilities.

COMPACTOR KEYS

- A key or is required to operate all waste compactors. The Centre Management Cleaning team will provide an initial training session on compactor operating procedures upon delivery of these keys for the first time. It is essential for all retailers to ensure that any new staff members are trained on the operation of the compactor. It is important to remember to take the key to the dock each time to activate the compactor. This ensures that the compactors are always ready to accept waste.
- Separate all recyclable materials in-store to save time when arriving at the dock. This will guarantee that all potential recyclable materials are recycled and not disposed of into landfill. Remember we aim to recycle 50% of all waste generated on site.
- Retailers will incur additional cleaning costs in the event waste materials are disposed of incorrectly. This may include leaving waste in passages or on the dock or contaminating recycling streams with general rubbish.
- Retailers waste must not be disposed of into mall waste bins. All retailer generated waste must be disposed of through the dock waste process.
- Pallets used to deliver stock must be taken away by your delivery contractor and cannot be left on the dock or in passageways.
- If you notice a build-up of rubbish or area that requires cleaning, please contact Centre Management.
